The Board of Embalmers and Funeral Directors met for an Emergency Meeting at Williams Funeral Services at 753 McPherson Street, Mansfield, Ohio 44903, to discuss the Funeral Home application from Triplett Chapel of Peace LLC. For the Triplett Funeral Home. Pamela Williams-Briggs, Vice President, called the meeting to order at 2:02 P.M. Other Board members present were: Robert C. Carter, Thomas Fleming, Ty Marsh. Staff Members present were: Malik M. Hubbard, Executive Director. In accordance to RC 4717.03 the Board met the necessary quorum requirements to conduct business and take action.

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Mrs. William-Briggs recognized Mr. Tim Rankin, counsel for the Triplett Chapel of Peace Funeral Home and allowed him to make a statement. Mr. Rankin stated that he believed an Amended Temporary Restraining Order filed with the Common Pleas Court of Franklin County, Ohio (Case No. 11-CVH08-10270) and licensing requirements under the law would allow him to continue to operate as Marlan J. Gary Funeral Home instead of Triplett Funeral Home.

The Board explained to Mr. Rankin that operating under the name of Marlan J. Gary Funeral Home Chapel of Peace would not be compliant under the R.C. due to a break in service of that funeral home and that the Board would be voting on the last application which was submitted by Mr. Triplett. The last application submitted was under the firm name Triplett Funeral Home by Triplett Chapel of Peace LLC.

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On a motion by Mr. Fleming, seconded by Mr. Marsh, the Board voted to approve the application for the Triplett funeral home license for the existing facility because of a change of ownership. Roll Call Vote: Carter, Aye; Fleming, Aye; Marsh, Aye; Williams-Briggs, Aye. Motion Passed.
