

Minutes of the September 26, 2018
Regular Meeting of the Board of Embalmers and Funeral Directors

Wednesday, September 26, 2018

Pursuant to 4717.03(A) of the Ohio Revised Code, the State of Ohio Board of Embalmers and Funeral Directors convened in Room South A of the Vern Riffe Center for Government and the Arts located at 77 South High Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215 for its regular meeting to discuss the Board's business.

1. Convening of the Board – President Rettig

Calling of the Roll

President Jon W. Rettig, Sr. called the meeting to order at 10:34 am. Executive Director David A. Ingram called the roll for the meeting. The following board members were in attendance of the meeting:

Marcella Boyd Cox; Edward C. Nurre, Jr.; Jill R. Pugh; Adriana A. Sfalcin; and officers: Jon W. Rettig, Sr., president; Thomas Taneff, vice-president.

Mr. Ingram announced that William C. Wappner was absent. He added that Mr. Wappner's absence from the meeting today was known in advance and thus excused. Mr. Ingram stated for the record a quorum of the board was present.

Pledge of Allegiance

Recognize Apprentices

During apprenticeship, apprentices are required to complete assignments published to their corresponding apprenticeship task list. One of the tasks cataloged, as an additional training requirement, is to attend one state board monthly meeting. This new task was established by the Board July 26, 2016 for one-year apprentices that started their apprenticeship February 1, 2016 or beyond; and for two-year apprentices that started their apprenticeship February 1, 2015 or beyond.

The Board would like the opportunity to recognize apprentices in attendance of the

meeting who are fulfilling this requirement.

Jon Rettig welcomed all apprentices in attendance of the meeting and requested each person to stand and state their name so all may hear. In attendance were Joseph Barnett, Heather Day, John Freeman, Carol Hill, Laura Ingram, Melissa Kemp, Carrie Latham, Eric McCarter, Alexa Oehlers, Lisa Qualls, and Alexis Schuppin.

Mr. Rettig also welcomed and introduced the following others in attendance: Carl Barnett; Elizabeth Brown; Kathy Elkins of Funeral Consumers Alliance of Central Ohio; Marlan Gary of Buckeye State Funeral Directors and Embalmers Association; Ellen Rettig, and Pamela Williams-Briggs, former president of the Ohio Board of Embalmers & Funeral Directors.

Mr. Rettig also identified members of the board office staff in attendance of the meeting for benefit of the apprentices. In addition, he welcomed Christie Limbert, board counsel, back from her previous absences due to other assignments.

Mr. Rettig announced that the Board would like to recognize Linda Clark on her forthcoming retirement. He requested Ms. Clark to join him and Mr. Ingram in standing in front of all attending the meeting. Mr. Rettig read aloud a “Proclamation of Retirement” from John R. Kasich and Mary Taylor, Ohio Governor and Lieutenant Governor, recognizing Linda Clark’s twenty-two years of service to the State of Ohio. Mr. Rettig presented the document to Ms. Clark and complimented her on her service and asked if she wished to say any words.

Ms. Clark thanked Mr. Rettig and stated that her time with the Board has been a wonderful experience. She shared that the first three years of employment with the board office was in a temporary position. She thanked Ann Cunningham for eventually adding her to the staff.

Ms. Clark declared that funeral directors and embalmers are honorable professions. She understood that many are following a “calling” to help others. Ms. Clark told the apprentices in attendance of the meeting that the job will sometimes be difficult but rewarding because they were helping people – usually at a vulnerable time in their lives. She advised the apprentices to always be kind to families.

Jeanine Hampton, niece of Linda Clark, concluded the ceremonial recognition by sharing word that her aunt has always been an inspiration to her and was proud to look up to Ms. Clark. Ms. Hampton also expressed thanks to David Ingram for assisting her with Ms. Clark’s retirement celebration.

Mr. Rettig conveyed William Wappner’s congratulations to Ms. Clark on her retirement in his absence.

2. Board Business

Executive Director's Report

David Ingram introduced a new employee of the board, Heather Jones. Ms. Jones will be taking the licensing and certification examiner position vacated by Linda Clark. Mr. Ingram stated that Ms. Jones has experience with the funeral industry by way of her eighteen years of service with the Ohio Department of Health, Office of Vital Statistics in Richland County. Heather Jones recently held the position of Deputy Registrar of Richland County General Health District. Mr. Ingram welcomed Heather to the board office staff.

David Ingram read aloud the content of the executive director's report and communicated the following in addition:

- Mr. Ingram commented that the Board's monthly expenditures will be reviewed at next month's meeting since Secretary-Treasurer William Wappner was out.
- Mr. Ingram reported that he recently presented at the 8th Annual Administrative Law Seminar hosted by the Ohio Bar Association. Mr. Ingram, along with Christie Limbert, board counsel, and Attorney Poul Lemasters, discussed the Board's Preneed Recovery Fund and Ohio laws concerning the funeral industry.
- Mr. Ingram reported the Preneed Recovery Fund experienced its best quarter to date with a seventeen percent (17%) increase from the first reporting period.
- Mr. Ingram reported that the 2019-2020 license renewal began on September 10, 2018. He reminded all that a licensee must have completed the continuing education requirements prior to renewing their individual license(s). The deadline to renew licenses remains on or before December 31, 2018.
- Mr. Ingram informed that any crematory that has not completed and returned to the board office the purple-colored form designating the crematory operator actually-in-charge of the facility will not be able to renew its crematory license until received. He reported that only one-half of the total number of forms mailed out were returned so far.

Mr. Rettig questioned Mr. Ingram how he planned to follow-up with the remaining facilities that have not submitted the form. Mr. Ingram replied that he and Danny Finfrock have contacted the facilities.

- Mr. Ingram announced that House Bill 161 will become effective on October 29, 2018. The bill includes clean-up of the Board's statutory language and more. Christie Limbert added that the bill also includes changes effecting cemetery care.
- Mr. Ingram read aloud briefly from his legislative timeline.
- Mr. Ingram read aloud numbers derived from the inspections report.

President's Report

- Jon Rettig requested the executive director of the board to tell of a recent visit the two of them had to the Ohio State University (OSU). Mr. Ingram stated that Abigail Wexner reached out to initiate a conversation about OSU's ideas on creating an apprenticeship program for the Body Donor Program in the Division of Anatomy at the OSU College of Medicine. She invited Mr. Ingram and Mr. Rettig to meet with faculty to discuss the prospect and tour the facility. Mr. Rettig thanked Mr. Ingram for his explanation. He added that the school would be exempt from the Board's laws and rules under Chapter 4717.
- Mr. Rettig requested board members to bring their calendars to the next meeting to discuss and schedule future board meeting dates in 2019.

Multiple Apprentice Request

David Ingram stated that a request to appear before the board was submitted by John Mueller of Mueller Funeral Home of Mason, Ohio. Mr. Mueller is seeking permission from the Board to serve as a master trainer of more than one apprenticeship at a time. Mr. Ingram informed the appearance has been deferred to the next meeting.

Consideration of the August 22, 2018 Board Meeting Minutes

Thomas Taneff made a motion for the Board to approve the August 22, 2018 Board Meeting Minutes as presented.

David Ingram informed that consideration of the committees meetings minutes has been deferred to the next meeting.

Licensure

David Ingram informed that all individual licenses approved at today's meeting will be conditional upon verification from board office staff that all documentation associated to an application for license has been received, reviewed, and accepted.

Jon Rettig read aloud the list of names of individuals recommended for licensure.

Jon Rettig made a motion for the Board to approve the applications of individuals

recommended for licensure as presented.

David Ingram informed that all facility licenses approved at today's meeting will be conditional upon verification from board office staff that all documentation associated to an application for license has been received, reviewed, and accepted.

Jon Rettig read aloud the list of names of facilities to be licensed and facility name changes.

Edward Nurre made a motion for the Board to approve ratification of facility licenses as presented.

Continuing Education

Jon Rettig requested Jill Pugh to report on the recent Continuing Education Committee meeting. Ms. Pugh responded that the committee has concerns about licensees earning continuing education hours for attending board and/or business meetings conducted by associations and organizations. The Committee recommends the Board discontinue approval of continuing education hours for these types of meetings. There was discussion among the Board on content and quality of such meetings. There was consensus among the Board that business meetings typically do not provide educational value to a licensee.

Marlan Gary of Buckeye State Funeral Directors and Embalmers Association asked for clarification on which meetings would not count towards continuing education hours: board or business? David Ingram responded to Mr. Gary by stating that both future board and business meetings will not be approved, starting January 01, 2019. Mr. Gary questioned if the decision to discontinue approval was made by the Board as a policy or as a rule. He also asked if there will be a public hearing if it was by rule. Mr. Rettig responded to Mr. Gary stating that the Board has discretion to approve or disapprove continuing education programs.

Mr. Gary respectfully disagreed with the Board's opinion about board and business meetings conducted by associations and organizations. He expressed belief that these meetings are educational and questioned if the Board would consider establishing criteria for groups to meet to retain credit hours. He suggested groups submit copy of meeting minutes to show the content was as outlined in the approved program.

The Board agreed to discuss this topic further with Mr. Gary and invited him to attend the next meeting of the Continuing Education and Examination Committee. Mr. Ingram commented that he would send a notice by email to stakeholders about the upcoming meeting. Mr. Ingram affirmed to Mr. Gary that the Board welcomes his participation and suggestions.

Jill Pugh made a motion for the Board to approve the applications for continuing education programs as presented.

Jon Rettig read aloud the name of the applicant requesting the fifty-year exemption of the continuing education requirements. He reminded all that an individual licensed as an embalmer or funeral director for not less than fifty years may apply if the licensee is not designated as actually-in-charge of an embalming facility or funeral home. Mr. Rettig also read aloud the name of the applicant requesting a waiver of the continuing education requirements. He reminded all that a waiver is for those with a physical disability, illness or undue hardship and is valid only for a two-year compliance period. He added that approval of a waiver, exemption, or fifty-year exemption does not waive or exempt the licensee from renewal fees. In addition, Mr. Rettig read aloud the names of the two applicants requesting credit for out-of-state continuing education hours.

Mr. Rettig questioned David Ingram if the vote for the applications may be combined. Mr. Ingram replied that they could be combined.

Marcella Boyd Cox made a motion for the Board to approve the application for exemption for fifty years of licensure, the application of waiver of the continuing education requirements, and the individuals' requests for out-of-state continuing education credit as presented.

Mr. Rettig asked Mr. Ingram about exemptions for persons serving the military. Mr. Ingram replied that the Board, along with other boards and commissions, provides eligible licensees opportunity to extend their reporting period equal to the time served in active duty. He added that the rule is in Administrative Code 4717-9-01(B).

David Ingram informed that there were no compliance cases for consideration to close at this time.

David Ingram informed that there were five (5) settlements for consideration at today's meeting.

Jon Rettig questioned if approval of all the settlements may be combined in one vote. Mr. Ingram replied that they could be combined.

Jill Pugh made a motion for the Board to ratify Settlement Agreements #1 through #5 as presented.

Prior to adjournment, Mr. Rettig asked aloud if anyone had any comments to make. Marlan Gary remarked that this board meeting was educational and worth the one hour of continuing education credit.

Jill Pugh made a motion for the Board to adjourn its meeting.




